



Larmandier-Bernier Tradition 1er Cru Extra Brut NV

- Blend of varieties 90% Chardonnay, 10% Pinot Noir
- Blend of sites; Vertus, Oger, Cramant, Chouilly
- Blend of vintages; 70% 2008 and reserve wines



2007 Muga Reserva

- Blend of varieties; 70% Tempranillo, 20% Garnacha, 10% Mazuelo and Graciano
- Blend of sites; in Rioja Alta and rest of region
- Wood



2010 Chablis 1er Cru Vaucopin, Domaine Béru

- Small 1er Cru
- Steep south east facing on the right bank of Serein, rocky
- Fine, pure very Chablis.

2010 Chablis 1er Cru Montée-de-Tonnerre, Athénaïs

- Lots of sun, heavier soil than Vaucopin
- Weight and ripeness typical right bank Chablis.
